Greenwood Service Notes

The National Institute for Occupational Safety and health (NIOSH) recently issued a bulletin relating to aerial ladders with a pinned movable waterway nozzle!

There have been several incidents where the monitor and last section of the waterway launched from the aerial, one of which resulted in a L.O.D.D.

Be advised that E-ONE aerial ladders have a secondary mechanical stop welded to the fly section (as illustrated)



to prevent the waterway trolley assembly from sliding off the fly section.
